Dean shared the following budget updates:

Key Financial Points:

- Offertory continues to be below budget \$143,000 below our goal.
- Total revenues are running ahead of budget. However, this includes restricted donations that can't be spent for general operations of the church (Columbarium, Food Pantry, EFAM, Respect Life, etc.).
- In order to continue funding church operations at existing levels (staff, ministries, etc.) we need to increase offertory by approx. \$175,000 / year (approx. \$50/registered family / year)



Key Capital Needs:

- Growing With Grace: Report to follow
- BAA: \$100k +/- actual vs \$120k goal (460 families have donated)
- Several other Capital Projects in progress:
 - Storage Building: Still needs \$100k to complete.
 - Rectory Bedroom Suite: Construction in progress. Funded thru Pastor's Discretionary fund at \$25,000.
 - It was mentioned that questions have been raised regarding this and suggested that we communicate to the parish that we are simply finishing the storage space over the Rectory garage, not adding an extension to the building.
