Growing with Grace

- Number of pledges received to date: 696 (some of the pledges are a one-time contribution)
- Grand total in pledges: \$3.1 million (roughly)
- Total of gifts received including gifts toward a pledge: \$556,000 (this includes the \$45k from the food sales and other events towards GWG)
 - Next food sale to benefit the Growing with Grace will be held the weekend of October 19/20th.
- Faith Formation children are collecting donations to bring in weekly so that they can be a part of the campaign and expansion of our church.

400K Matching challenge:

- Since July there have been \$93,000 in new pledges and/or gifts from approximately 80 new contributors.
- Reminder, any new pledges and/or new gifts received between now and September 28th, our International Food Festival date, will be matched up to a maximum of \$400,000!
- Lynn Frank is coordinating volunteers to be present at the information table at the Food Festival that will include information on the upcoming Services Raffle to ensure businesses offer their services.

BAA

- Our BAA goal has been reached!
- \$121,098 gifts have been made to the BAA this year.

Increased Offertory

• Father Clemente will work with Carmen on this committee after the Food Festival concludes.

Welcoming Committee

- With the guidance of Father Dass, we are working with Chris Holmes, Terry Maynard, Regina Ryan, John Issigonis, Eleanor Edwards, and Maria Magdalena on this project.
- Targeting a simple process to welcome new parishioners.
- We saw the need to update our ministry/group listing as it was not up to date.

Deacon Talks, Deacon Mike

- Deacon Mike shared that he has retired from his full-time job and is excited to further his spiritual career at St. Ann's.
- He is working on implementing a new program at St. Ann's that supports the involvement of individuals with special needs.
- Deacon Mike's office hours are Monday and Wednesday: 10a.m.- Noon. He is working with folks on spiritual concerns and the various ministries (e.g. Respect for Life).
 - Deacon will be at mass on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings as well as at the Saturday 4:30 p.m. and Sunday 7:30 a.m. masses

He is also assisting with daily mass and will be conducting daily communion services while the priests are away on retreat next week.

*The remainder of the cost to complete the Community Outreach Center has been allocated from the church's operational fund. This does not stop the current fundraising efforts. The projected completion date for the building is the end of October 2024.

The full financial update was not available due to the change in our meeting schedule. Month-end reports were not yet complete.

Updates and Discussion Items:

PC Email Status - Chris Vozdik

Chris has worked with Frank to place a "comment" submission page under the Parish Council section of the website. This allows parishioners to ask questions of the council and assist the priests with parishioner outreach/questions. This form is not anonymous; an email address and contact information is required. The hope is that parishioners may also bring a suggested improvement if they bring up a concern. Council members noted that the placement of the feedback page could be better placed on the website. Voz will work with Frank on sharing the input provided by the council.

PC Election Process Update - Anne Miller

The team researched the possibility of an online election process, but this is not feasible due to the lack of technology access and/or skills for some parishioners. Another option proposed was having both a paper ballot and online ballot option, but due to bandwidth issues, this is also not an option. The team discussed their research with Father Peter, and it was decided to keep a paper ballot for elections with some changes to the process. The paper ballots will be handed to parishioners as they enter the church and then collected at the end of mass (someone at each exit point – side and back). Pencils will be placed in the pews. The minor changes to the distribution and collection of ballots will prevent interruptions during mass and the impact on the ushers.



A/V Update - Nick Petro

This past weekend we started showing the post-communion announcement prior to each mass via the projectors. Nick has offered to continue doing this each week. Several council members concurred that this may be a good option to replace the reading of announcements at each mass as they are numerous and lengthy.

Speaker Update - Nick Petro

Two speakers have been replaced (they were on hand, no purchase required). The two speakers had blown transformers causing an overpowering sound in the front pews.

Live-streaming Stats - Nick Petro

New Mass Times - Father Peter

Father shared that the current time In between masses is inadequate, and, in addition to parking concerns, parishioners miss the community aspect. It also shortens the time available for faith formation classes.

Father is considering the following options for Sunday mass times: (no changes to Saturday vigil Masses or Sunday evening Masses)

- 7:30 a.m.
- 9:30 a.m.
- 11:30 a.m.
- 1:30 p.m.

Adjacent Properties – Father Peter

- Father asks that we keep praying. He noted that it is a sign of trust from the bishop and diocese that they are willing to consider purchasing the land and are in negotiations for the property to the north of the church and prayers are needed for the property to the south of the church.
- The diocese is willing to loan St. Ann's the money to purchase the parcel to the north (approx. \$1 million).
- The 66-acre property to the south of the church is in negotiations with the diocese to get a fair price (\$5 million estimated).

Diocese of Raleigh 100th Anniversary – Father Peter

Lori is working on event coordination for our parish with Father Peter.

- Gala \$750 per person or \$7500 per table (to support the Catholic Charities).
- Celebration(s) within/around St. Ann Parish (masses in a couple of different locations)
